Eligibility

We are accepting patients who meet **ONE** of the following criteria:

- Have run out of visits and are still in need of therapy
- Unable to access appropriate pediatric PT services
- In need of initial PT services but are on a long wait list elsewhere

Can be seen without a referral only if the child has an official diagnosis made by a physician.

- ⇒ Please know that your child's services will be intermittent, such as once every 4-6 weeks, so our focus will be teaching you how to help your child.
